### PART-TIME STAFF POSITION: 20 hours per week

- You will have an ability to actively draw upon congregation and broader performing arts community in welcoming musicians, singers and artists to participate and be a part of our community
- You will help build the vision of where HUC needs to go in connecting spirituality, music and the arts, and what HUC needs to do to get there
- You will supervise and support our skilled adult and youth choral directors and accompanists

- You will identify needs for musical programming and take the initiative to pursue and develop them
- You will display your passion for community building and achieving performance potential in our annual spring musical production

# What You Bring....

- Strong musical and choral leadership background in sacred and secular contemporary music are core to this role and you will be comfortable incorporating secular music into worship in a meaningful way
- Experience managing a diverse musical arts program, including conducting, managing rehearsal schedules, coordinating staff and volunteers and contributing to worship planning
- You will have exceptional interpersonal skills and willingness to honour a range of musical and vocal gifts, both professional and amateur, in an affirming and inclusive church culture
- Willingness to be flexible in planning weekly, thematic music selections, as a key member of our Worship Planning and Staff Leadership teams. Also vital is a passion for seeing the potential in others and to take the church's vision and create, develop and implement a strategic plan to achieve that vision
- Theological alignment with the United Church of Canada is a necessary component

#### The Details....

- Work schedule will be approximately 20 hours per week (some seasonal variance) onsite and/or online where you will:
  - Prepare for the weekly, monthly or seasonal worship services or special service music
  - Attend monthly staff leadership planning meetings and weekly Worship Planning team meetings
  - Attend weekly choir, hymn leadership team or special performance group rehearsals honouring the gifts and perspectives of those serving in our small music groups or choirs
  - Attend Sunday worship services to oversee delivery of what has been created for that service
  - Get connected with our congregation and find the hidden talents willing to join your team and the performance opportunities you've created
  - Integral part of the production and direction team for our annual Spring Musical production
  - Be responsible for church assets related to our music programs and to identify facility and equipment improvements
